


READY SET DANCE

Enrolment

You can enrol now and secure your position in a class. Fees are required for the term and if your little one is a little shy or unsure we recommend giving them a term to settle in to gain all the benefits that our dance classes will bring them.

Trial Classes

If you would prefer an obligation-free trial class, contact our office to arrange one. Please note that booking a trial class does not guarantee you a position in the class until you enrol. We offer free trial classes in all our classes (as long as there are vacancies in the class).

CAN I WATCH THE CLASS?

There is a viewing window at our venue in The Ponds so you are encouraged to share in your child's dance journey. Bella Vista parents can watch the class via CCTV on our television screen in the reception area. We also provide an opportunity every lesson for parents to watch from inside the studio, as the last component of the class involves a demonstration by the students. Parents may take photos and be involved in their child's progress and the children love having the chance to perform their skills and receive applause.

DO I NEED TO PURCHASE A UNIFORM?

If you enrol at the conclusion of your first free trial class you will receive a free uniform. If you enrol anytime after this, the uniform can be purchased for \$35.00 (Girls) \$20.00 (Boys).

WHAT SHOES DO I WEAR?

Students are encouraged to wear:

- Tan jazz shoes for girls or black jazz shoes for boys (no laces are easier for little ones)
- Tan tap shoes for girls (optional) or black tap shoes for boys (optional)

The shoes are available from dancewear retailers such as Bloch in Rouse Hill Town Centre, The Ballet Emporium in Baulkham Hills and Centre Stage in Seven Hills.

ARE THERE ANY OTHER COSTS?

The only costs that are required is registration (\$34) and the lesson fees. Any other items are optional.

IS THERE A CONCERT?

There is an optional concert in a theatre for Bella Vista/Norwest Ready Set Dance students. Ready Set Ballet Students and all students at The Ponds and Rouse Hill are invited to participate in a free in-class concert the last week of Term 4 where they perform the work they have been learning in class to their families and friends. No tickets, costumes or make-up is required.

WHEN ARE FEES DUE?

Fees are due at the commencement of the term. If you join mid-way through the term, the fees are calculated pro-rata and are due on your first lesson.

IF I MISS A CLASS DO I HAVE TO PAY?

Fees are a term commitment and are charged for each lesson in the term. If you are unable to attend a lesson, you can do a make-up class. Please contact us to arrange this. Due to child safety reasons these need to be arranged in advance.

CAN I BRING A FRIEND?

Friends make dancing fun! You are welcome to refer your friends to Ready Set Dance and if they enrol you will receive a free hair bow as a token of our appreciation. Please let our receptionist know if you qualify.

TELL ME MORE ABOUT CAPER SCHOOL OF PERFORMING ARTS?

At Caper we are passionate about developing our dancers as they grow beyond their pre-school years. We cater for our tiniest dancers right up until their last year of high school. The goal for our 2-5 year olds is to instill a love of dance that can continue to be nurtured as they grow beyond their pre-school years. We do not approach our pre-school classes with a short-term view. Everything is done for the long-term benefit of the child. We focus on ensuring our students' developmental needs are considered every step of the way.



Terms & Conditions

SCHOOL RULES

- Parents and carers are to stay on site for the duration of their child's class.
- Teacher supervision extends only to students in class.
- Parents are liable for any damages caused to property by their children.
- Class times include up to a 5-minute window for arrivals and dismissals (i.e. the first few and last few minutes of class involve students being marked on the roll or dismissed to their parents).
- By entering the premises, parents accept that risks may exist in attending or participating in the events or activities held in the venue. We do not accept any responsibility arising from attendance or participation in an event or activity or the actions or negligence of other persons present.

FEE PAYMENTS

- Payment is accepted via EFTPOS or electronic funds transfers only (no cash or cheque).
- A registration fee of \$34.00 per student is required annually.
- Classes are charged by the term.
- Fees are calculated pro-rata. For instance if a student joins in Week 3 of a 9 week term, fees will be owing for Week 3 through to Week 9 only.
- Fees are due at the commencement of classes.
- Free trial classes are available before registering.
- There is no further discounting of fees.
- Fee payments must be up to date in order to participate in classes.

PRE-SCHOOL CANCELLATION POLICY

- Registration is valid for the entire calendar year however classes can be cancelled at the end of each term.
- Ready Set Dance students may cancel from classes within the first three weeks of commencing without the need to pay for classes they did not attend. They are required to pay for the weeks they attended. If a student withdraws after the first three weeks of commencing, families will be required to pay for the whole term.

IMAGE CONSENT

Students may be photographed or filmed by staff during classes. These images could be used for promotional purposes via media such as online, social and print. Parental permission is assumed unless otherwise advised.

COMMUNICATION

- Caper students and their parents are not to communicate with teachers via social media, email, phone or other forms of communication. Caper staff are duty bound to deny any social media friendship requests or followers.
- All communication should be directed via phone, email or to reception in person whilst classes are being held.
- Teachers should not be disrupted during class arrivals and dismissals as the their attention needs to be with the students and ensuring child safety.

I am aware that by enrolling in the above classes I am agreeing to the Terms and Conditions. In particular, I accept responsibility for payment of all the enrolled classes for the term regardless of attendance.
